Eastbrook Road, Waltham Abbey	<b>North West Side:</b> from a point in line with the shared boundary of 27 and 29 Eastbrook Road, south westwards for a distance of approximately 5 metres.
Roundhills, Waltham Abbey	South West Side: from a point approximately 4.5 metres north west of the shared boundary of 131 & 133 Roundhills, south eastwards for 5.4 metres.

Conyers Way, Loughton	North West Side: from a point in line with the shared boundary of 21 and 23 Conyers Way, south westwards for a distance of approximately 6 metres.

Giesthorp Court, Waltham Abbey	North East Side: from a point approximately 0.8 metres south west of the shared boundary of 19
	and 20 Giesthorp Court, south westwards for a distance of approximately 5 metres.
