

The Essex County Council (Colchester City) (Prohibition of Waiting, Loading and Stopping) and (On-Street Parking Places) (Civil Enforcement Area) (Amendment No.38) Order 202*

STATEMENT OF REASONS:

The Local Highways Panel have requested a dropped kerb crossing across the mouth of Titania Close at its junction with Avon Way, Greenstead Estate in Colchester LCOL 203001. This is probably the only side road along Avon Way that doesn't have dropped kerbs, thus allowing Disabled Users and push chairs to safely cross the road. As this design is being produced in accordance with The Construction, Design and Management Regulations 2020, the designer has to ensure that the crossing is safe to use. Part of this safe use is the ability for the pedestrian to see on-coming traffic and vice versa. This inter visibility is impaired by vehicles persistently parking on the south side of Titania Close outside of property number 2. Hence the need to extend the existing double yellow lines by approximately 20 metres .
