The Essex County Council (Various Roads, Great Easton) (40mph Speed Limit) Order 202*

The Essex County Council ("the Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 81, 82(2), 83(2), 84(1) and (2) and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act hereby makes the following Order: -

- 1. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to proceed at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour in the said lengths of roads in the Parish of Great Easton in the District of Uttlesford as specified in the Schedule to this Order.
- 2. No speed restriction imposed by this Order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with regulation 3 (5) of those regulations.
- 3. The restriction imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation of any restrictions or requirements imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act or by or under any other enactment.
- 4. 'The Essex County Council (Various Roads, Great Easton) (40mph Speed Limit) Order 2009' as specified in the schedule to this Order is hereby revoked in its entirety. The restrictions imposed shall remain in force by virtue of this Order.
- This Order shall come into operation on *********202* and may be cited as The Essex County Council (Various Roads, Great Easton) (Restricted Roads and 40mph Speed Limit) Order 202*
