

Public notice

The Essex County Council (Various Roads, Great Easton) (40mph Speed Limit) Order 202*

Notice is hereby given that the Essex County Council proposes to make the above Order under Sections 81, 82(2), 83(2), 84(1) and (2) and Parts III and IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

Effect of the order: To extend the existing 40mph Speed Limit on the following length of Gallows Green Road, Great Easton in the District of Uttlesford (the road is currently derestricted):

Road	Description
Gallows Green Road, Great Easton	From a point approximately 12 metres west of its junction with Breach Lane (joining the existing 40mph Speed Limit) in an easterly direction for an approximate distance of 1180 metres.

'The Essex County Council (Various Roads, Great Easton) (40mph Speed Limit) Order 2009 is hereby revoked in its entirety. The restrictions will continue in force by virtue of this Order.
