## The Essex County Council (Basildon Borough) (Prohibition of Waiting, Loading and Stopping) and (On-Street Parking Places) (Civil Enforcement Area) (Amendment No.31) Order 202\*

## **STATEMENT OF REASONS:**

Due to vehicles being parked with two wheels up on the pavement along the access road between property numbers 35 and 37 Ardleigh, residents are being prevented from accessing and exiting their garages. The parked vehicles are also blocking access for pedestrians and wheelchair users when trying to cross the road at the junctions dropped crossing.

There is only space for one vehicle per house, therefore there is likely to be an overspill of parking. As there are currently no parking restrictions along these areas, Councillor Smith has requested that No Waiting at Any Time parking restrictions be installed along both sides of the road in order to prevent vehicles from parking on the pavement.

By implementing the proposal, residents will be able to access and exit their garages, and pedestrians will be able to cross the road safely at the junctions dropped crossing.
