

**The Essex County Council (Various Roads, Epping Forest)
(Combined Speed Limits) Order 202***

The Essex County Council (hereinafter referred to as "The Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 81, 82(2), 83(2), 84(1)(a) and (2), and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act") (as amended), and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act, hereby make the following Order: -

1. The roads detailed in Schedule 1 to this Order shall become restricted roads for the purposes of section 81 of the Act.
2. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to be driven at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour on those lengths of road, in the District of Epping Forest as specified in Schedule 2 to this Order.
3. The restriction imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation of any restrictions or requirements imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act or by or under any other enactment.
4. No speed limit imposed by this Order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with Regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
5. 'The Essex County Council (A104 Epping New Road, Buckhurst Hill) (Restricted Road) Order 2008' is hereby revoked in its entirety, however, the restrictions contained within that Order shall be continued in force by this Order.
6. Schedules 1 and 2 of 'The Essex County Council (Various Roads, Epping Forest) (40MPH, Restricted Road, 20MPH Speed Limit & Zone) Order 2012' will be revoked by this Order, any restrictions unaffected by these proposals will be continued in force by this Order.
7. This order shall come into operation on and may be cited as The Essex County Council (Various Road, Epping Forest) (Combined Speed Limits) Order 202*.

Schedule 1

Restricted Road and 30mph Speed Limit

Road	Description
A104 Epping New Road, Buckhurst Hill, Loughton	From a point approximately 30 metres south of its junction with Whitehall Lane, northwards to a point approximately 62 metres north of its junction with Rangers Road, approximately 1,819 metres.
Epping New Road (Unclassified Road), Buckhurst Hill	From its junction with the main carriageway of the A104 Epping New Road, east and south for approximately 40 metres.
Avey Lane, Waltham Abbey	From a point approximately 77 metres east of its junction Sewardstone Road, south-eastwards to a point approximately 62 metres northwest of its junction with Manor Road.
Church Road, Waltham Abbey	From its junction with Mott Street, south-westwards to its junction with Lippitts Hill.
Claypit Hill, Waltham Abbey	From its junction with Pynest Green Lane, south-westwards to its junction with Wake Road.
Cross Roads, Waltham Abbey	From a point approximately 53 metres south of its junction with Nursery Road, south-eastwards to a point approximately 61 metres northwest of its junction with the A104 Epping New Road.
Earl's Path, Loughton	From its junction with the A104 Robin Hood Roundabout, in a south-easterly direction to a point approximately 10 metres from the southwest kerb line of Smarts Lane.
Forest Side, Waltham Abbey	From a point approximately 97 metres south of its junction with the A121 Honey Lane, southwards to its junction with Pynest Green Lane.
Lippitts Hill, Waltham Abbey	From its junction with Mott Street, south-eastwards to its junction with Church Road.
Motts Street, Waltham Abbey and Loughton	From its junction with Sewardstone Road, eastwards to a point approximately 26 metres west of its junction with Avey Lane.
Wake Road, Waltham Abbey	From its junction with the A121 Woodridden Hill, south-westwards to a point approximately 95 metres northeast of its junction with Nursery Road, approximately 1760 metres.

40mph Speed Limit

Road	Description
A104 Epping New Road, Buckhurst Hill, Loughton	From its junction with the A121 Wake Arms Roundabout in a south-westerly direction to a point approximately 62 metres north of its junction with Rangers Road, approximately 4,000 metres.
A1069 Rangers Road, Buckhurst Hill, Loughton	From its junction with the A104 Epping New Road in a south-westerly direction for approximately 520 metres.
A121 Goldings Hill, Loughton	From its junction with the A121 Wake Arms Roundabout, southwards to a point approximately 8 metres from the northwest kerb line of Baldwins Hill.
A121 Honey Lane, Waltham Abbey	From a point approximately 58 metres west of the extended kerb line of Waltham Abbey Jewish Cemetery in an easterly direction to its junction with the A121 Woodridden Hill.
A121 Woodridden Hill, Waltham Abbey	From its junction with the A121 Honey Lane, eastwards to its junction with the A121 Wake Arms Roundabout.
B1393 Epping Road, Waltham Abbey	From its junction with the B1393 High Road to its junction with the A121 Wake Arms Roundabout.
B1393 High Road, Epping	From a point approximately 75 metres from the extended western kerb line of <i>the B182 Bury Lane southeast</i> to its junction with the B1393 Epping Road, approximately 1809 metres.
B172 Coppice Row/Jacks Hill, Waltham Abbey, Loughton, Theydon Bois	From its junction with the A121 Wake Arms Roundabout, eastwards to a point on Coppice Row, approximately 110 metres northwest of the common boundary of the properties Forest Edge and Ye Old Almshouse.
Avey Lane, Waltham Abbey	From its junction with Sewardstone Road to a point approximately 77 metres east of that junction.
Bury Road, Waltham Abbey	From its junction with Daws Hill to a point approximately 8 metres north of the northern side of the access road to Knoll House.
Cophall Green, Waltham Abbey	From its junction with Crown Hill in a westerly direction to a point approximately 2.5 metres west of the southeast boundary of 'Ferns Hollow', Crown Hill, Upshire.
Cross Roads, Waltham Abbey	From its junction with the A104 Robin Hood Roundabout in a north-westerly direction for approximately 61 metres.
Daws Hill, Waltham Abbey	From its junction with Sewardstone Road to its junction with Bury Road.
Forest Side, Waltham Abbey	From its junction with the A121 Honey Lane in a southerly direction for approximately 97 metres.
Piercing Hill, Theydon Bois	From its junction with Theydon Road in a southerly direction to a point approximately 220 metres north of its junction with Morgan Crescent.

Theydon Road, Theydon Bois	From its junction with the B1393 in a southerly direction to its junction with Piercing Hill.
Woodgreen Road, Waltham Abbey	From its junction with the A121 Honey Lane in a northerly direction for approximately 60 metres.
