

# Public notice

## The Essex County Council (Various Roads, Epping Forest) (Combined Speed Limits) Order 202\*

**Notice is hereby given** that the Essex County Council proposes to make the above Order under S81, 82(2), 83(2), 84(1)(a) and (2) and Part IV and Part III of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended)

### Effect of the order:

#### 1. To Extend: a '30mph Speed Limit' (Currently a 40mph Speed Limit)

Road	Description
A104 Epping New Road, Buckhurst Hill, Loughton	From a point approximately 67 metres north of its junction with Fernside north for approximately 1,017 metres to a point approximately 62 metres north of its junction with Rangers Road.
Epping New Road (Unclassified Road), Buckhurst Hill	From its junction with the main carriageway of the A104 Epping New Road, east and south for approximately 40 metres.

'The Essex County Council (A104 Epping New Road, Buckhurst Hill) (Restricted Road) Order 2008' is hereby revoked in its entirety, however, the restrictions contained within that Order shall be continued in force by the new Order.

Schedules 1 and 2 of 'The Essex County Council (Various Roads, Epping Forest) (40MPH, Restricted Road, 20MPH Speed Limit & Zone) Order 2012' will be revoked by this Order, any restrictions unaffected by these proposals will be continued in force by the new Order.
