

Public notice

The Essex County Council (Various Roads, Stanway, City of Colchester) (20mph Zone) Order 202*.

Notice is hereby given that Essex County Council proposes to make the above Order under Sections 84(1) (a) and (2) and Part III of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended).

The Effect of the Order:

To Implement: A 20mph Zone in Stanway, in the City of Colchester.

Road	Description
Butterfly Trail (Including Private Drives)	From a point approximately 10 metres north of its junction with Halstead Road, North, East, then South for its entire length.
Dragonfly Drift (Including Private Drives)	From its junction with Butterfly Trail, West for its entire length.
Skipper Grove (Including Private Drives)	From its junction with Butterfly Trail, Sout, then East for its entire length.
Ringlet Lane (Including Private Drives)	From its junction with Butterfly Trail, East, then South for its entire length.
Swallowtail Glade (Including Private Drives)	From its junction with Butterfly Trail, East for approximately 123 metres.
Brimstone Chase (Including Private Drives)	From its junction with Swallowdale Glade, South for its entire length.
Lacewing Green (Including Private Drives)	From its junction with Swallowdale Glade, North for its entire length.
