Notice is hereby given that the Essex County Council proposes to make the above Order under Sections 23, 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 3(2), 4(1), 4(2), 32(1), 35(1), 45, 46, 49, 53 and Part III & IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 the Essex County Council proposes to implement a zebra crossing and amend waiting restrictions on the following lengths of The Commons in the Borough of Colchester.

Effect of the order: To revoke and amend No Waiting at Any Time restrictions due to the implementation of the proposed crossing repositioning on The Commons in the Borough of Colchester.

 To revoke the existing No Waiting at Any Time at Any Time restrictions at the following locations

The Commons	North Side: From a point approximately 26 metres East of the middle			
	of the junction with Plume Avenue, in a westerly direction for			
	approximately 29 metres			
The Commons	South Side: From a point in line with the boundary of property No. 55			
	The Commons, in a westerly direction for approximately 24 metres			

- 2. To Implement No Waiting At Any Time, The Commons, Colchester **South Side:** From a point approx. 8 metres west of west boundary of property no. 55 The Commons, east for approximately 38 metres.
- To Implement a Zebra Crossing, The Commons, Colchester
 The Centre line of the crossing: Approximately 12.6 metres east of the west boundary of property No. 55 The Commons. Width between the crossing give way lines: Approximately 6.7 metres.

Zebra Crossing Zig-Zags, The Commons, Colchester

North Side: From the eastern give way line, east for approximately 4.4 metres. From the west give way line, west for approximately 21.6 metres.

South Side: From the eastern give way line, east for approximately 17.2 metres. From the west give way line, west for approximately 4.4 metres.
