

The Essex County Council (Maldon District) (Holloway Road, Barbrook Avenue, Heybridge) (20mph Speed Limit) Order 20**

The Essex County Council (“the Council”) in exercise of its powers under Section 84(1) (a) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the Act”) and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

1. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to be driven at a speed exceeding 20 miles per hour on the various roads, in the Town of Maldon in the District of Maldon as specified in the Schedule 1 to this order.
2. No speed restriction imposed by this Order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
3. This Order shall come into operation on ***** and may be cited as The Essex County Council (Maldon District) (Holloway Road, Barbrook Avenue, Heybridge) (20mph Speed Limit) Order 20**

Schedule

1. To introduce a 20mph zone on the following lengths of roads in the District of Maldon: Barbrook Avenue: From a point approximately 12 metres northeast of the junction with Holloway Road in a north easterly direction for the entire length of the estate of Barbrook Avenue.
