The Essex County Council (Maldon District) (Holloway Road, Barbrook Avenue, Heybridge) (20mph Speed Limit) Order 20**

The Essex County Council (Maldon District) (Prohibition of Waiting, Loading and Stopping) and (On-Street Parking Places) (Civil Enforcement Area) (Amendment No.8) Order 20**

Notice is hereby given that the Essex County Council proposes to make the above Order under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 3(2), 4(1), 4(2), 32(1), 35(1), 45, 46, 49, 53, 84(1) (a) and (2) and Part III & IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The effect of the Order:

1. To Implement No Waiting At Any Time restrictions on the following lengths of road in the District of Maldon:

Road	Description
Holloway Road	From its tangent point of the north western kerb line with Barbrook Avenue in a northwesterly direction for approximately 40 metres and from its tangent point of the southeastern kerb line with Barbrook Avenue in a southeasterly direction for approximately 15 metres
Barbrook Avenue	Both Sides: From its junction with Holloway Road in a northeasterly direction for approximately 15 metres.

2. To introduce a 20mph zone on the following lengths of roads in the District of Maldon:
Barbrook Avenue: From a point approximately 12 metres northeast of the junction with Holloway Road in a north easterly direction for the entire length of the estate of Barbrook Avenue.

This Order will be incorporated into The Essex County Council (Maldon District) (Prohibition of Waiting, Loading and Stopping) and (On-Street Parking Places) (Civil Enforcement Area) Consolidation Order 2019 by replacing tile number TL845 085 revision 0 with TL845 085 revision 1.
