## The Essex County Council (Various Roads, Brightlingsea) (20mph Zone) Order 202\*.

**Notice is hereby given** that the Essex County Council proposes to make the above Order under sections 84(1) and (2), and Part III of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended).

**To Implement:** A 20mph Zone in Great Bentley in the District of Tendring.

Road	Description
Brian House Court	From its junction with Stephens Drive, West for its entire length, including any turning heads.
Chapman Close	From its junction with Keats Crescent, West for its entire length, including any turning heads.
Keats Crescent	From its junction with Robinson Road, South-West for its entire length, including any turning heads.
Middleton Mews	From its junction with Keats Crescent, South for its entire length, including any turning heads.
Pannell Place	From its junction with Middleton Mews, South its entire length, including any turning heads.
Stephens Drive	From its junction with Wilfreds Way, South for its entire length, including any turning heads.
Sycamore Mews	From its junction with Wilfreds Way, West for its entire length.
Wilfreds Way	From its junction with Robinson Road, for its entire length.
