#### **Engagement: February / March 2017**


#### Key issues identified:

- Unreliable and long journey times
- Lack of alternative transport options
- Road safety issues
- Impact of poor air quality on health.


#### Key feedback received – call for:

- Buses to have priority on the network over other motorised vehicles;
- More reliable bus services and quicker journey times
- Facilities for pedestrians and cyclists to be improved to encourage people to walk and cycle more
- Improved safety, security and lighting of cycle routes
- Introduction of more segregated cycle routes.











#### **Public Consultation: July / August 2017**

- 921 responses received, including from Councils, Businesses and other organisations
- One petition submitted with 1,628 signatories, regarding Baddow Road Bus Gate.

#### Top 3 schemes by prioritisation:

- Broomfield Road Corridor
- Army & Navy Roundabout Improvements (Parkway Corridor)
- Chelmsford City Centre Cycling Connectivity



# Chelmer Valley Road: Bus Priority Measures and Highway Capacity



















# Parkway - Permanent Left Turn Segregation




