 - 7.5t weight limit
 - Delivery Vehicles only between 6pm - 9am

 - Contra-flow cycle route between Victoria Road South and Tindal Square

- General traffic routes outside of restricted area**
- Delivery traffic route through restricted area**
- Buses only route**
