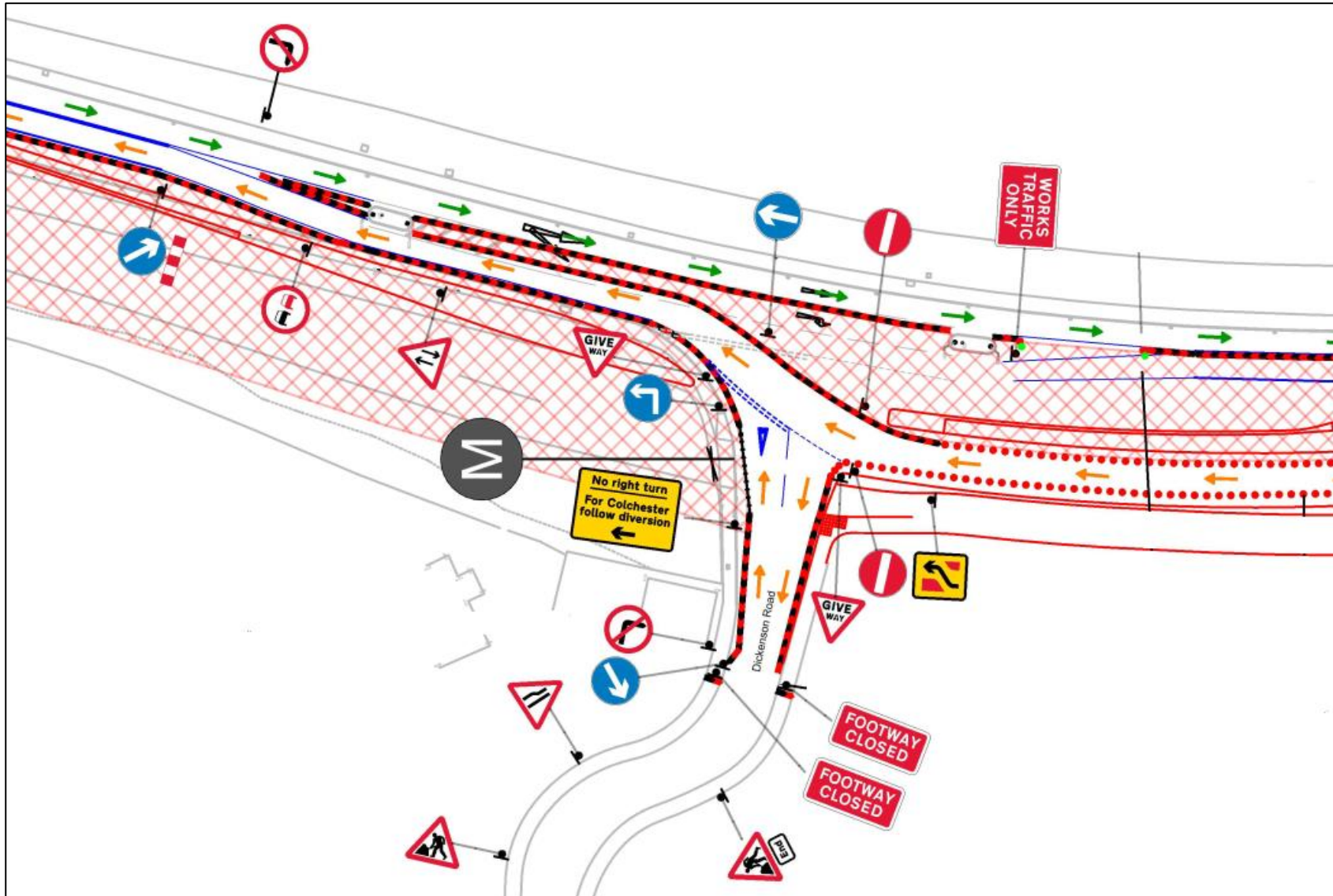

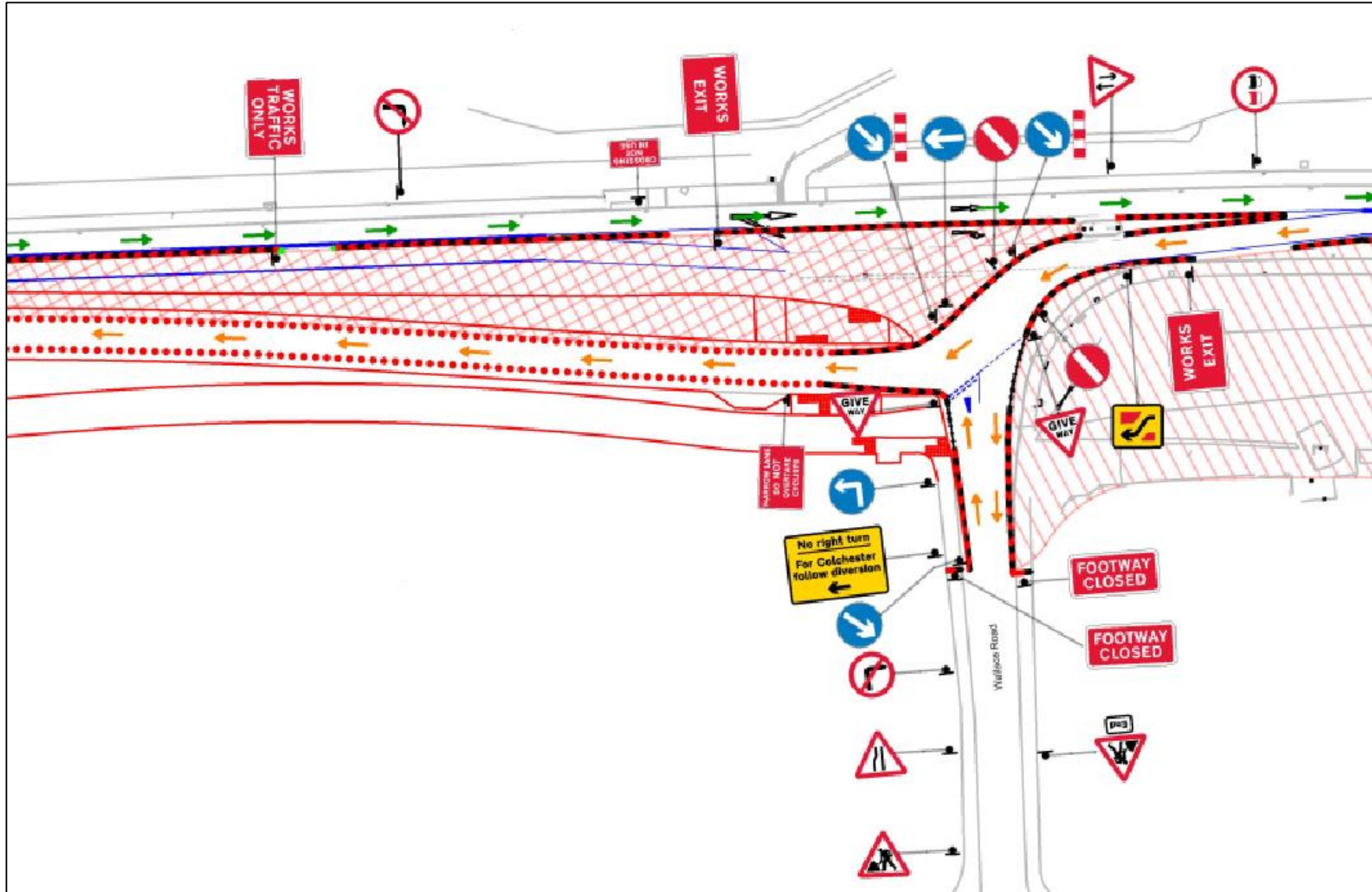
**Via Urbis / Mill Road footway closure** – The existing crossing marked by the red crosses is now closed because of the newly installed left filter lane on Mill Road East.

Pedestrians needing to access the eastern side of Mill Road will need to cross Northern Approach Road and follow the route below marked by the green dashes



**Temporary no right turn in or out of Dickenson Road and Wallace Road** – Access for southbound traffic into the estate will need to be made via the roundabout at the southern part of A134 (Northern Approach Road). Vehicles heading to Colchester centre from the estate will be diverted to the roundabout between Nayland Road and Boxted Road where they can then head back down the A134.
