3.	Lamp Columns in the Borough					
	Members of the Panel expressed their disappointment again that lamp columns that were no longer in use were not being removed from the highway. It was understood that part of the problem was due to a lack of co-operation from UK Power Network. The Chairman requested that a letter was sent from the Panel to the Cabinet Member for Highways and Transportation expressing this view and that the matter be raised with the Leader and Chief Executive of Castle Point Borough Council as well.					
	Central Wall Road, Canvey Island – Road Signs					
	Councillor Tucker reported that 3 signs at the junction to the one-way system had been partially removed. These included a 'No Entry' and 'One Way' signs and the beacon at the pelican crossing. Mark Evershed to arrange a meeting with the Managing Director of ECC Highways to discuss the matter of partially removed signs generally in the Borough. Also the Chairman to speak to the Cabinet Member for Highways. It was suggested that a list be compiled of locations of the signs.					
	Essex Way junction with Vicarage Hill, Benfleet - Speeding					
	Will Price stated that the Road Safety Team had advised against installing a trief kerb in this location. It was reported that one of the street lights in the location was not working which meant the junction was poorly lit. Councillor Reeves stated that she had reported the broken light on 4.12.2016 and it had still not been fixed. During discussion it was suggested that the only solution to the danger of speeding vehicles on the bend was to remove the bend altogether but that this would be costly.

	Will Price advised that the Castle Point LHP Capital budget for 2016/17 had been reduced to £228,675. All Panels had been recommended to commission an annual programme of 160% of their budget, thereby enabling a rolling programme of approved, deliverable schemes. ## CASTLE POINT BOROUGH COUNCIL WITH ESSEX COUNTY COUNCIL LOCAL HIGHWAY PANEL – 28<sup>th</sup> JUNE 2016 REPORT 1 – APPROVED SCHEMES UPDATE

At the panel meeting on the 22<sup>nd</sup> March the Castle Point Members recommended the entire budget of £228,675 following the budget amendments for the 2016/17 financial year.

In addition to successfully recommending 100% of the budget the Panel were also encouraged to provisionally recommend an additional 60% of budget to form a rolling programme, of which these schemes are distinguished on the programme as being for 2017-18 delivery. If members wish to make amendments to the programme they need to consider that there are likely to be abortive costs associated with amending any schemes which are already in investigation.

Priority for delivery this year has been given to schemes which have previously been subject to a detailed design or which can proceed straight to implementation and it is the intention that the first batch of schemes will be delivered by the end of Quarter 3. Specific dates will be provided when schemes have been formally programmed and road space booked.

The target for the remaining schemes will be Quarter 4 so that all feasibility studies and designs are complete and ready for Members to consider for funding within the 2017-18 financial year.
