Jaywick Roads Improvement Scheme

Your overview of resurfacing and drainage works in your area

Work starts early July, 2015 in Essex Avenue

General Information

Earlier in 2015 Essex County Council announced that £5m would be invested over two years, to improve the existing poor drainage and road conditions in parts of Jaywick. The improvement works will start from early July 2015. The principal contractor is Ringway Jacobs, in partnership with Essex County Council. Ringway Jacobs has engaged John Henry Group to undertake construction. The works may take up to two years to complete and there will be some local disruption whilst the work is taking place.

The work will include new road surfacing outside residents' homes in a number of areas (see map below), as well as clearing, improving and piping the main drainage ditch, to help reduce the risk of flooding in Jaywick.

We will carry out the improvements in several phases. The first phase will include surveys, the construction of a compound to host work crews' equipment and the improvements to the main drainage ditch. Road resurfacing will then start. In order to minimise disruption to residents and to ensure public access is kept as clear as possible, resurfacing of roads will start on Essex Avenue, followed by Humber Avenue with every second road being resurfaced in turn. Each remaining road will then be resurfaced, to complete the scheme. Unfortunately, while the construction works are under way in a street there will be no parking in that street. Residents will need to temporarily park their vehicles elsewhere. The work in each road may take some weeks to complete and will be dependent on the exact condition of the road, and the weather.
