COLCHESTER BOROUGH COUNCIL WITH ESSEX COUNTY COUNCIL LOCAL HIGHWAY PANEL – 2nd JUNE 2015 2015/16 POTENTIAL CAPITAL SCHEMES

From the scheme recommendations made by the Panel in 2014/15 there are currently schemes to the value of £525,195 which have been re-profiled and are being delivered in 2015/16.

At the March meeting Panel Members recommended schemes to the value of **£249,825** leaving a remaining capital budget of **£224,980**, however it is recommended to allocate the budget in its entirety.

The revenue budget remaining is **£10,971**
