From the schemes recommendations made by the Panel in 2014/15 there are currently schemes to the value of £367,000 which have been re-profiled and are being delivered in 2015/16. These schemes are detailed on the Approved Works Programme. Following discussion with the Chairman of the Panel, it is considered prudent for the Panel to make further recommendations against the 2015/16 Capital Budget of £133,000. This will ensure a recommended 2015/16 Capital Budget of £500,000 and will allow for any further scheme slippage.

The following Potential Scheme List identifies all of the scheme requests which have been received for the consideration of the Maldon District Local Highways Panel. There are currently schemes with an estimated cost of £304,050 as shown in the summary below:


<p>1.0</p>	<p><u>Brief</u></p> <p>To undertake a technical review of the signing and lining along the B1010 Lower Burnham Road, from Fambridge to Burnham on Crouch. To identify any conflicts between the No Overtaking (Diag:632) signs and the Double and Single white lining system, to ensure the route is signed and lined in accordance with the standards and best practise.</p> <p>This request came from the BNAP (Burnham Neighbourhood Action Panel)</p> <p>The funding for the Technical Review and preliminary design has been approved by Maldon LHP at £18,500.</p>
<p>2.0</p>	<p><u>Background</u></p> <p>The B1010 Lower Burnham Road is located mainly in rural land running from South Woodham Ferrers to Burnham on Crouch.</p> <p>Parts of the road are subject to no overtaking restrictions using both signage (Diag: 632) and lining to advise road users of the restrictions.</p>
<p>3.0</p>	<p><u>Existing Situation</u></p> <p>The BNAP (Burnham Neighbourhood Action Panel) has raised concerned regarding the no-overtaking restrictions currently implemented on the B1010 Lower Burnham Road, specifically the section of road leading towards the village of Althorne which currently has no overtaking (Diag: 632) signage to notify road users of the restrictions in place.</p> <p>After a review of the signing and lining on the B1010 Lower Burnham Road it was found there is a direct conflict between the lining and signing in place, The Traffic Signs Manual for Regulatory Signs 2008 states that '<i>No overtaking signs must not be used along the same length of road as double white lines</i>'.</p> <p>However there are sections of carriageway where the signing and lining restrictions overlap by up to 85m which could cause confusion to road users, there is also further inaccuracies with the information the existing distance sub-plates state.</p> <p>There is currently a sign and post missing on the approach to Althorne following an assumed RTC, the rest of the signs and posts vary in their condition, but remain visually unrestricted for road users on both approaches.</p> <p>The white lining on both approaches to the section of signed road and leading towards Burnham On Crouch is clear and is a good state of repair, therefore we do not feel it necessary to consider refreshing the lining.</p> <p>There is no street lighting along the section of Lower Burnham Road in interest.</p>

TECHNICAL REVIEW: DC3149 – B1010 Lower Burnham Road

<p>4.0</p>	<p><u>Options</u></p> <p>1. We looked at continuing the solid white lining through section of road leading towards Althorne, which currently has no overtaking signing installed, however the maximum width of the carriageway is 5.8m. According to the Traffic Signs Manual for Road Markings (Chapter 5 2003) the section of road is not suitable for the installation of solid white lining as the minimum suggested width is 6.1m.</p> <p>Therefore the option of extending the solid white lining throughout this section of road leading to Althorne which has the no overtaking signage installed would not be possible.</p> <p>2. Secondly we looked at the existing no overtaking signing (Diag: 632) and the distance plates, we felt this is the best option for the section of carriageway. We would propose to relocate signs that are currently in the wrong locations which could be causing the confusion and replace damaged or missing sign posts. Sign plates will be 750mm rather than the current 600mm ones to improve the visibility for motorists.</p>
<p>5.0</p>	<p><u>Solution</u></p> <p>Following the review of the B1010 Lower Burnham Road, we looked at the possible solutions to rectify the issues with the restrictions currently in place and feel the below will be the most suitable to address the highlighted issues with the section of road in question.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• The existing no overtaking (Diag: 632) signage will be changed for new signs and the size increased from 600mm to a larger 750mm sign plate to ensure that visibility of the signage is clear.• The existing damaged posts will be changed for new units and the missing post and signs will be replaced on the approach to Althorne village.• Two signs currently located on the southern verge will be removed to tip and new units installed as shown on the supporting drawing.• Distance sub plates (Diag: 570) will be replaced to show the correct distance for the section of road and length remaining which is subject to the no overtaking restrictions.• Hedge rows will be cut back as required around the signage to ensure the visibility. <p>See supporting drawing DC1-3149-00-001 for details.</p>
<p>6.0</p>	<p><u>Further Action</u></p> <p>Scheme to be reviewed and considered for approval by Maldon Local Highway Panel.</p>




