6.	Report on Schemes Awaiting Funding				JB	
	The HLO updated Members that the Schemes Awaiting Funding List identified those scheme requests which had been received for the consideration of the Epping Local Highways Panel (LHP). In February 2024 it was agreed, at ECC Full Council, that the 2024/25 Capital Budget for the twelve Local Highway Panels would remain the same as 2023/24. The Epping Forest LHP Capital Budget for 2024/25 will be £174,800. Also, in 2024/25 the Casualty Reduction Sites across the County are to be funded from a central pot of monies derived from the Chairman's Panel funding allocation. There are currently Schemes Awaiting Funding with an estimated cost of £1,257,750 as shown in the summary below:
