5. Report on Funded Schemes 2023/24

This report provides an update on the current position of all the schemes which the Tendring Local Highway Panel has recommended for inclusion in their 2022/23 programme.

James Drabwell (EH) noted Members were made aware of the budget summary and the remaining budget to allocate of £23,600. £2,500 has been ring fenced for a potential quiet lane scheme on Mill Street, Brightlingsea and requested match funding from the Parish Council.

Leaving an Outstanding balance of £21,100 to allocate today.

JD (EH) Explained there had been many meetings with the design department to allocate the schemes below, they are commissioned late into the programme so may not get delivered.

- LTEN212008 Norwood Way.
- LTEN193002 Marine Parade West, near Toby Carvery.

Both schemes were discussed as to the complexities involved and the desire to see the schemes progressed.

Members discussed the Funded Schemes 2023-24 and Cllr Platt (ECC) highlighted the last column which is headed Slipped schemes.

Cllr Stephenson (ECC) Notified the Hazelmere project did not appear on the list that was discussed two years ago and was concerned a scheme has been removed from the report without notification.

JD (EH) Explained that he will investigate and reinstate for the next meeting.

Cllr Stephenson asked why his scheme LTEN222058 St Johns Rd request wasn't successful and would like it to be revisited by the design team.

JD (EH) Confirmed it was on page 25 of the July paperwork and will investigate the system.

Cllr Goggin (ECC) Explained at Flag Hill the speed will be changing from 60 to 40mph and the requirement for installing in new signs. Was it an ECC initiative to replace signs and posts with passive posts, therefore replacing the original scaffold type pole signs with posts that collapse when hit.

He is very concerned with the costs if such a scheme existed.

Cllr Platt (ECC) believes that if this is the case that perhaps the Casualty Reduction Team should pick up the costs and not the LHP.

Cllr Goggin (ECC) Requested to put a formal question regarding the scheme to the new Portfolio Holder as the budget should not be coming from the LHP scheme.

JD (EH) Explained it was most likely to have been agreed by the designers and the new design has been accepted but that not all the posts will be renewed as the designs were at present work in progress so the final designs may change.

Cllr G Guglielmi agreed defects to signs should be the responsibility of Essex Highways and not the LHP.

 - It was discussed that TDALC are requesting for the whole of Alresford area to move to 20mph. Members agreed they would not want a blanket 20mph at TDC.
- LTEN222063 Requires specific works to the signs. Referred to Cllr G Guglielmi (ECC).

WALKING

- LTEN183006 and LTEN193002 Confirmed the designs are being worked on.
- LTEN203001 To be removed.
- LTEN213004 Very heavy with traffic, officers have visited the site and felt vulnerable. A large part of the scheme shall be needed for TM. A requirement to investigate the whole £94,000 funding.
- LTEN213028 Discussed being unable to drive a mobility scooter through.

PASSENGER TRANSPORT

Discussed schemes had been added without consultation.

- LTEN165050 and LTEN225001 Cllr G Guglielmi (ECC) had not been consulted with.
- LTEN195004 Is on hold with the Bus Stop strategy.
- LTEN195004 A request for justification. Awaiting a breakdown of the costs. Action - James Drabwell (EH) to request for a breakdown of the costs.

Discussed the Bus Stop strategy Cllr Alan Goggin (ECC) would approve of a seat and shelter at every bus stop.

Cllr Platt (ECC) informed members that Passenger Transport carryout their own surveys and then schemes are automatically included with the LHP without consultation. Cllr Platt (ECC) will contact Helen Morris and request members are consulted.

7. Report on Street surveys

Chair

Members discussed speed surveys to check which member is responsible for each survey.

Cllr G Guglielmi (ECC) Suggested Town and Parish areas should be responsible to pay for their own surveys.

Members discussed the need for the surveys as it is a way of collecting the data, it can provide evidence to the police and speeds have decreased.

Cllr Goggin (ECC) informed members that Alresford had purchased portable survey devices, they record the data and outline the statistics. The basic cost for a portable machine is £3,000.

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	Members discussed the benefits of having their own portable survey devices, moving the devices to different areas within Tendring District Council which are of particular concern. A licence would be required for the machines. There is a need to decide who would be responsible for the maintenance, storage, collecting the data and placement of the machines.

TENDRING LOCAL HIGHWAY PANEL REPORT 2 - SCHEMES AWAITING FUNDING LIST

This Schemes Awaiting Funding List identifies those scheme requests, which have been received for the consideration of the Tendring Local Highways Panel (LHP).

In February 2024 it was agreed, at ECC Full Council, that the 2024/25 Capital Budget for the twelve Local Highway Panels would remain the same as 2023/24. The Tendring LHP Capital Budget for 2024/25 will be £197,600. Also, in 2024/25 the Casualty Reduction Sites across the County are to be funded from a central pot of monies derived from the Chairman's Panel funding allocation.

The Panel are now asked to review the schemes on the attached Schemes Awaiting Funding List and consider their further scheme funding recommendations for those they wish to see delivered in 2023/24.

The Panel may also remove any schemes they would not wish to consider for future funding.

There are currently Schemes Awaiting Funding with an estimated cost of £554,000, as shown in the summary below -
