1. Welcome & Introductions

The Chair welcomed the Panel.

2. Apologies for Absence

3. Action Log of the Previous Meeting

The action log from the previous meeting was agreed.

4. Matters arising from minutes of previous meeting

5. Opportunity for public questions

Cllr Sue Meyer from Little Hallingbury asked about the 2 x sets of flashing wig-wags in Little Hallingbury which have not been working since around 2019. ST explained that the maintenance of this equipment falls to ITS rather than the LHP, ITS have been contacted previously about the 2 sets in Little Hallingbury and advised they had no resources to action replacement, ST to enquire further about this.

Cllr Nigel Robley raised the issue of the flashing wig-wags in Hatfield Heath which do not appear to be damaged but are not coming on at any time – ST to raise this with ITS.

Katrina Levy Clerk of Widdington Parish Council enquired as to progress of a scheme for some safety signage for Springhill in order to slow down traffic and protect pedestrians where there is no footway – this scheme is currently in validation (scheme LUTT222004)

Cllr Geoffrey Sell from Stansted requested a progress update on 11 schemes the Parish Council had submitted to the LHP. It was mentioned that some schemes were in validation and others were awaiting surveys before they could be progressed, others were determined not to be feasible.

Cllr Gooding also made representation on behalf of the Headteacher of Joyce Frankland Academy and asked about a scheme for a raised table which was a funded scheme in 23/24. ST explained that she had been advised this was a Section 106 scheme but has been unable to find out any up-to-date information about progress – ST to obtain an update from colleagues responsible for section 106 programme and report this back to Cllr Gooding.

6. Report on Funded Schemes

Cllr Gadd requested some clarity on what has been spent in 2023/24 – DM to provide.

The panel would like more information on how section 106 monies can be utilised as there is some confusion and a lack of information on how this process works.

ST advised some of the incomplete schemes from 23/24 are now considered to be 'in-scope' for the Chairs Panel rather than the district panel. ST to circulate list of schemes agreed to be potential Chairs Panel schemes to the panel members (this includes 2 scheme which are awaiting funding) in order that they can be prioritised for funding.

7. Report on Schemes Awaiting Funding

The panel agreed not to commission any of the schemes awaiting funding until the Chairs Panel have met and we know which schemes will be funded by the Chairs Panel – 8 schemes marked to take to Chairs Panel from this meeting.

Cllr Barker pointed out the scheme 13 High Cross Lane (LUTT212003) stated the Parish as Little Canfield when it should be Great Canfield – ST to amend.

UTTLESFORD LOCAL HIGHWAY PANEL REPORT 2 - SCHEMES AWAITING FUNDING LIST

This Schemes Awaiting Funding List identifies those scheme requests, which have been received for the consideration of the Uttlesford Local Highways Panel (LHP).

The agreed Uttlesford LHP Capital Budget for 2024/25 was £118,000. At the April 2024 Panel meeting Members made Scheme funding recommendations to a value of £47,000. There remains £71,000 of the 2024/25 LHP Capital Budget which the Panel can now use to make further scheme funding recommendations against.
