

## **Decision Notice**

## Street tree consultation

Notice was given under S115 of the Environment Act 2021 and 96A of the Highways Act 1980 that this tree is considered for removal (Notice CAS013066).

Following a 28-day consultation period, a number of objections were received in relation to the felling, which have been considered. The comments included concerns that the trees were being felled for the following reasons:

- They are causing damage to the Highway.
- There had been complaints of leaf fall.
- It is an insurance stipulation but that no evidence had been provided.

Despite this, Essex Highways will still require the tree to be felled for the following reasons:

- The trees are causing significant damage to adjacent properties through subsidence, which is a legal nuisance. The trees have been implicated through the relevant monitoring and investigation reports, which have all been fully assessed.
- In response, the trees were heavily reduced in February 2024, however, this did not abate the nuisance and further evidence concludes this.
- The only remaining option is to fell the trees.

We will implement a replacement scheme in conjunction with the Essex Forest



Initiative for suitable trees that are less likely to be a subsidence risk in the future. These will be planted in due course.
