

Duty to ConsultOn Felling Street Trees

This is a notification that this tree is proposed to be felled. From the date of this notice, there is a 28-day period in which you can provide comments on the proposed tree removal. This notice meets the requirements set out in section 115 of the Environment Act 2021 and section 96A of the Highways Act 1980 on the duty to consult.

Species: Turkish Hazel

Reason for removal: To alleviate damage to the footpath and the adjacent property.

Solutions considered: Engineered solutions have been considered, however the location of the tree and proximity to private property determine that this is not a suitable alternative remedial action long term. Damage is likely to reoccur, and alternative solutions could lead to the tree becoming unstable. Therefore, removal is the only option available to fully alleviate the damage.

Replacement: Replacement planting is not considered appropriate in this location, given the potential for future damage to occur. The verge is too narrow. Alternative locations in the area will be sought.
