

The Essex County Council (Various Roads, Chelmsford) (7.5 tonne Environmental Weight Restriction) Order 202*

The Essex County Council (hereinafter referred to as “the Council”) in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (4), 3(2) and 4(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 [hereinafter referred to as 1984 Act] and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9, hereby make the following Order:-

1. In this Order:-

“goods vehicle” means a motor vehicle or trailer constructed or adapted for use for the carriage or haulage of goods or burden of any description

2. Save as provided in Article 3 of Order no person shall cause any goods vehicle having a maximum permissible gross weight exceeding 7.5 tonnes shall proceed in the said length of roads in the City of Chelmsford as specified in the Schedule to this Order [hereinafter referred to as the said length of roads].

3. Nothing in Article 2 of this Order shall apply so as to prevent any goods vehicle having a maximum permissible gross weight exceeding 7.5 tonnes to proceed in the length of roads if the vehicle is being used:

(a) Except any holders of permits issued by Chelmsford City Council from proceeding along the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this order;

(b) except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform;

(c) for fire and rescue, police or ambulance purposes, in the exercise of their duties;

(d) is being used in connection with any of the following operations, namely;

(i) in connection with any building or demolition operations in or adjacent to the length of roads;

(ii) for the removal of any obstruction to traffic in or adjacent to the length of roads;

(iii) for the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction in or adjacent to the length of roads;

(iv) for the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or on land adjacent to the length of roads, of any sewer, or any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of water, gas or electricity, or any telegraphic line;

(v) in the service of a local authority or water authority in connection with work being carried out in or on land adjacent to the length of roads, in pursuance of statutory powers or duties; or

(vi) for removal of commercial refuse from commercial properties on or adjacent to the said length of roads;

4. The Council is satisfied that for preserving or improving the amenities of an area by prohibiting or restricting the use on a road or roads in that area of heavy commercial

vehicles it is requisite that Section 3(1) of the 1984 Act should not apply in relation to this Order.

5. This Order shall come into operation on ***** and may be cited as the Essex County Council (Various Roads, Chelmsford) (7.5 tonne Environmental Weight Restriction) Order 202*.

Road	Description
Conduit Street, Chelmsford	From its junction with High Street to its junction with New London Road and Tindal Street.
High Street, Chelmsford	From its junction with Moulsham Street to its junction with Tindal Square.
Moulsham Street, Chelmsford	From its junction with Baddow Road and Barrack Square to its junction with High Street
Springfield Road, Chelmsford	From its junction with the High Street to its junction with the Kings Mead Roundabout.
Tindal Square, Chelmsford	From the extended kerb line of Duke Street and Tindal Street to its junction with New Street.
New Street, Chelmsford	From its junction with Tindal Square to its junction with Waterloo Lane.
