

**The Essex County Council (Cherrydown West, Basildon) (Prohibition of Right Hand Turn) Order 20\*\***

The Essex County Council ("the Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1) and (2), 2(1) to (3), and 3(2) of the road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act"), and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

1. In this order  
'authorised vehicle' means any vehicle being used for Fire and Rescue, Police or Ambulance purposes.
2. This Order may be cited as the Essex County Council (Cherrydown West, Basildon) (Prohibition of Right Hand Turn) Order 201\* and shall come into operation on \*\*\*\*\*.
3. Save as provided in Article 4 no person shall cause any vehicle to make a right hand turn from Cherrydown West in to Station Way in the Town of Basildon in the Borough of Basildon [hereinafter referred to as the said length of road].
4. Nothing in Article 3 of this Order shall apply so as to prevent any person from causing any authorised vehicle to make a right hand turn in the said length of road.
5. The restriction imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation of any restrictions or requirement imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act or by or under any other enactment.
