

# Public notice

## The Essex County Council (Various Roads), (Chesterwell Development), (Myland), (20mph Zone) Order 202\*

**Notice is hereby given** that Essex County Council proposes to make the above Order under Sections 84(1) (a) and (2) and Part III of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

**Effect of the order:** To introduce a 20mph Zone on the following lengths of roads (Chesterwell Development), Myland in the Borough of Colchester:

Road	Description
Cordelia Drive, Myland	From a point approximately 348 metres from its junction with Wildeve Avenue (A134) in a Southerly direction for an approximate distance of 287 metres.
Maigold Avenue, Myland	From its junction with Cordelia Drive in a Westerly direction for an approximate distance of 335 metres.
Mandarin Way, Myland	For its entire length.
Sunfire Way, Myland	For its entire length.
Sapphire Crescent, Myland	For its entire length.
Pascali Lane, Myland	For its entire length.
Felicia Lane, Myland	For its entire length.
Bonita Walk, Myland	For its entire length.
